#### Main characteristics

- Chronic venous insufficiency (CVI) High exudate levels Deep venous thrombosis (DVT) Irregular sloping margins
- Secondary venous hypertension secondary to

\*Arteriosclerosis (chronic arterial obstruction)

\*Arterial thrombosis/ embolism Hypertension

Mixed aetiology, with predominance of venous

- · May be painful Oedema, redness Medial side of the lower leg, often internal
  - · Presence of dermatological periwound signs: ochre dermatitis,
  - white atrophy, hypopigmented plaques

• Fibrinous, granulating base

• Single, multiple or even circular

Lipodermatosclerosis

Usually shallow

- Normal peripheral pulses
- Punched out, sharply demarcated edges
- Painful
- Small and deep Necrotic wound base · Dry to low exudate levels
- Pale skin, cramps, hair loss, skin and nail atrophy
- Decreased or absent peripheral pulses

Mixture of signs and symptoms

Wound bed preparation; promote granulation (do not use autolytic debridement in ischaemic limbs/digits), Pain
